Tag questions: B. A. 1 Sec C

.

Tag questions are the questions which are attached to the end of a statement to give it an added force.

Rule: we use a negative tag with a positive statement and a negative statement takes a positive tag. The verb remains the same as in question.

For example

- 1. He writes a letter, doesn't he?
- 2. We have plenty of time, haven't we?
- 3. We haven't much time, have we?
- 4. None of the food was wasted, was it?
- 5. We saw no one we knew, did we?
- 6. A small scratch like this is nothing, is it?
- 7. We seldom see them these days, do we?
- 8. He is very clever, isn't he?
- 9. She looks III, doesn't she?
- 10. Your car is damaged, isn't it?
