- **6.** Critically examine the grand style of John Milton in *Paradise Lost Book-I*.
- 7. Justify the status of Satan as hero in *Paradise Lost Book-I*.

UNIT-IV

- **8.** Write a critical note on Shakespeare's treatment of Love in *Twelfth Night*.
- **9.** Write an extended note on the intricacies in the fusion of plot and sub-plots in *Twelfth Night*.
