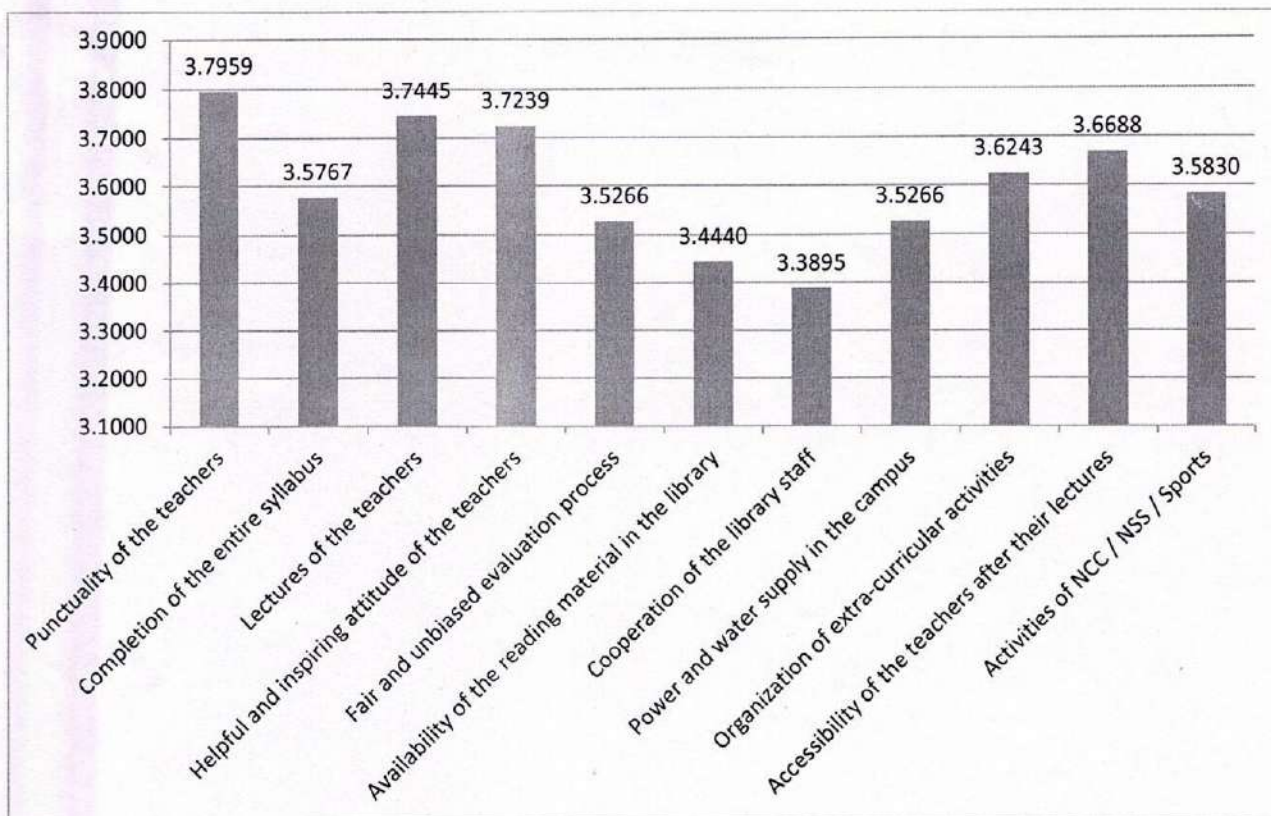

The highest mean score is 3.80 for punctuality of the teachers. Compared to the result of previous year it is gradually getting upward showing a good positive trend on curriculum implementation. The report is transferred to the IQAC for further discussions and deliberations.

Action Taken Report on Students' Feedback

(2021-22)

- Feedback on issues related to the transactions of curriculum like teaching, learning and evaluation was collected from the students in blended mode using Google forms and by circulating the feedback forms.
- Google forms were sent to the students through their respective Whatsapp groups.
- Feedback forms were provided to the students by their respective mentors.
- The statistical data was collected by the feedback committee.
- Total number of the students who provided feedback was 1597.
- This year 1062 students furnished feedback offline and 535 students filled in Google Forms.
- The collected feedback was put before the IQAC of the college for further analysis and discussion and finally the feedback report was recommended by the IQAC to be uploaded on the website of the college.
- To increment the availability of the reading material in the library, more books will be purchased.
- The number of members of the library staff will be increased.
- More reading space will be arranged for the students in the library.
- Separate washrooms will be constructed in the library.

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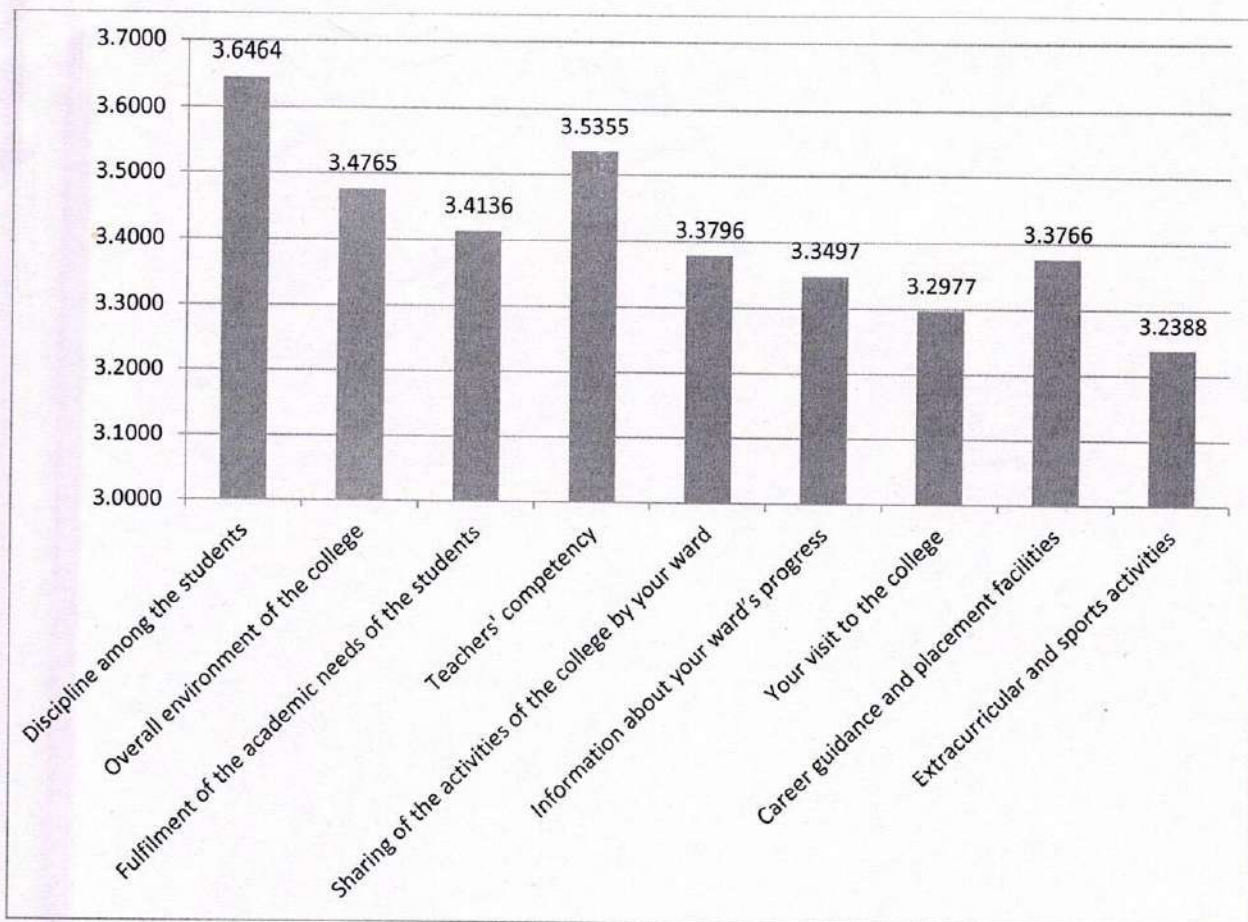

- A receptionist will be appointed in the reception hall.


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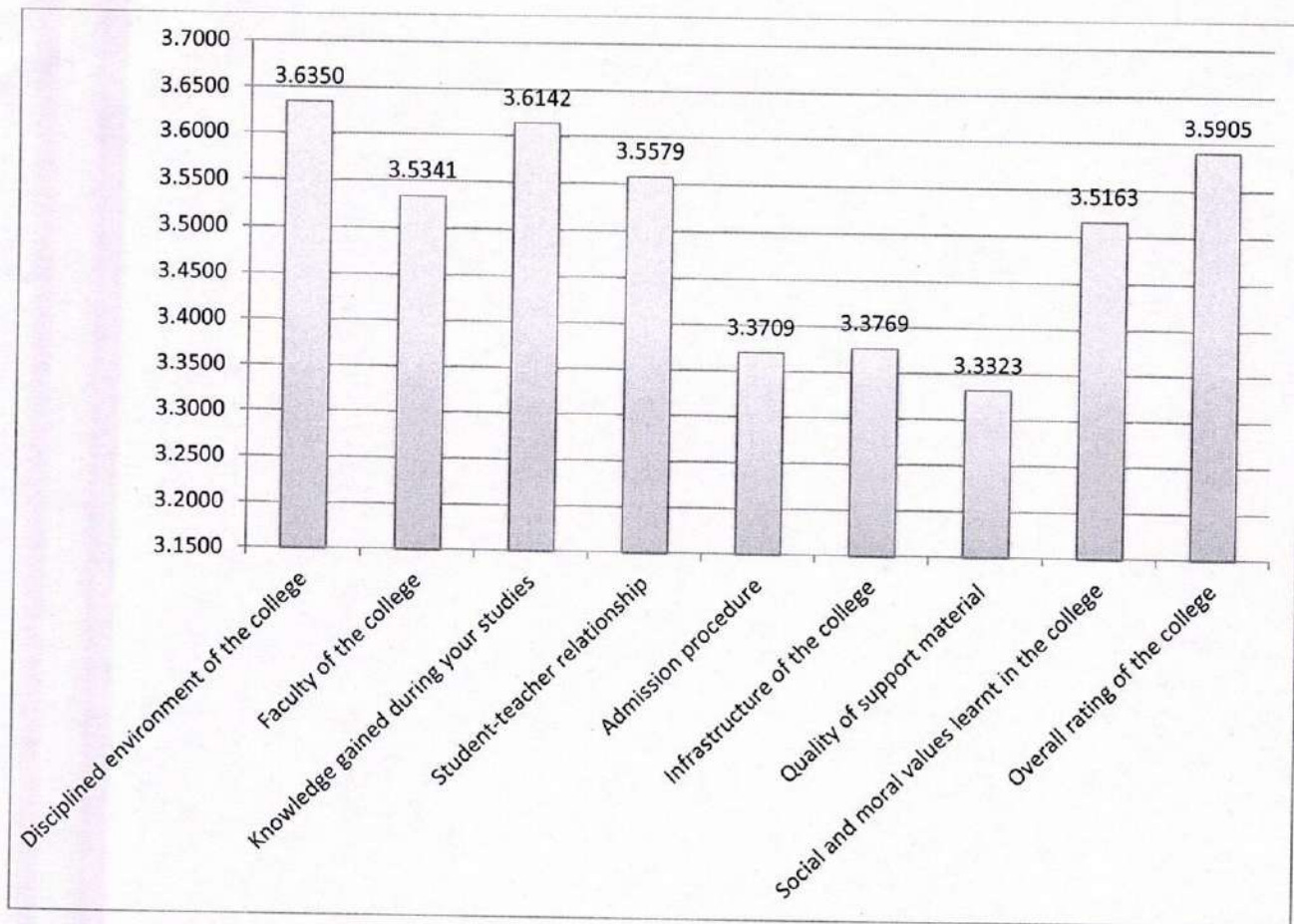

Action Taken Report on Alumni's Feedback

(2021-22)

- Feedback on curriculum and its transaction at the institution was collected from the alumni in online as well as offline mode.
- The Google Forms were shared in both the Whatsapp groups of alumni.
- Alumni's feedback was collected during alumni meetings.
- Alumni filled in feedback forms whenever they visited the college.
- 337 was the number of alumni who recorded their feedback.
- Feedback through Google Forms was provided by 141 alumni while 196 alumni furnished feedback through offline feedback forms.
- The collected feedback was put before the IQAC of the college for further analysis and discussion and finally the feedback report was recommended by the IQAC to be uploaded on the website of the college.
- To smoothen the admission procedure for the students, free registration facility will be arranged in the college campus.
- Apart from registration facility, a counselling team will also guide the students.
- A new yoga room will be set up.
- Faculty members will be consistently encouraged to improve upon their knowledge base through participation in conferences and seminars.


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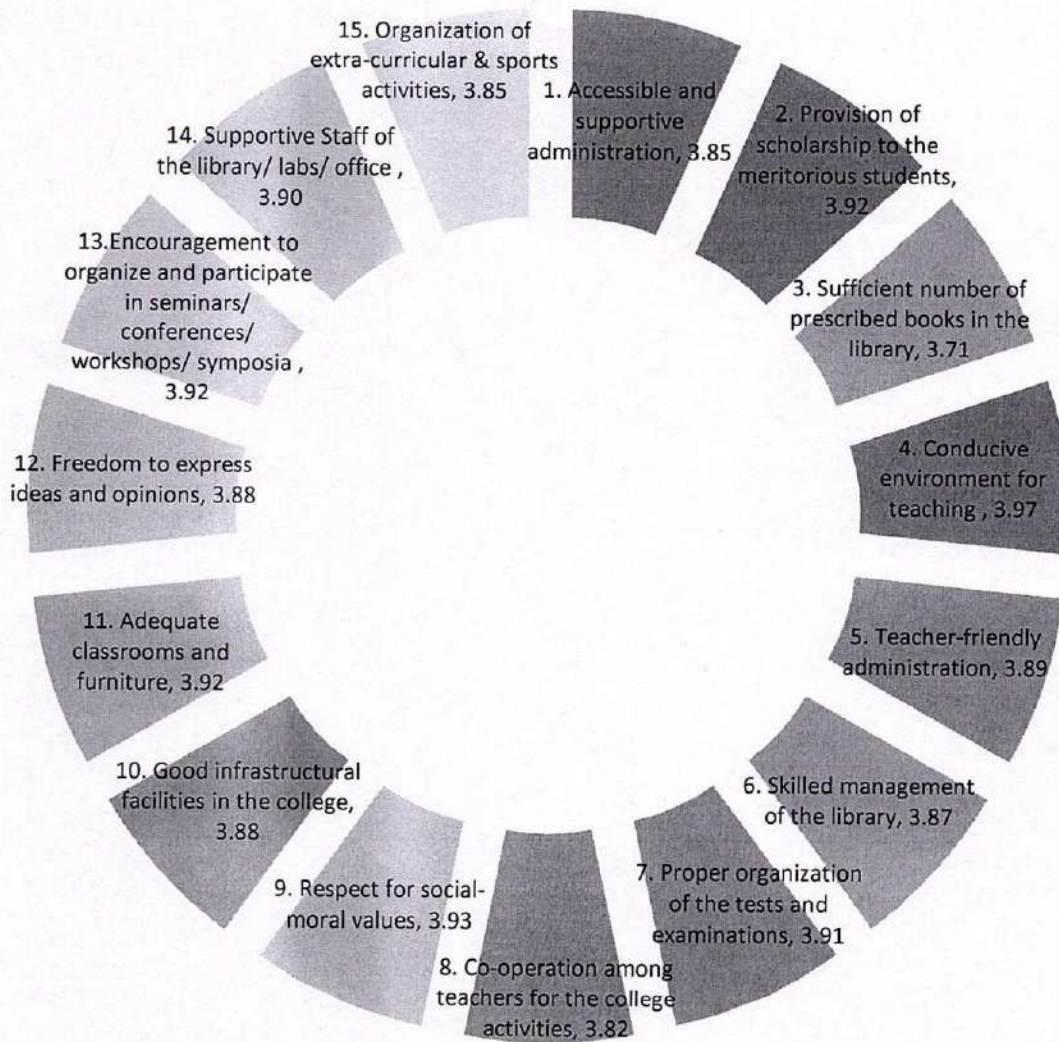

Based on the above table and chart it is evident that on all the parameters the means of teachers' responses have been above 3.8. The highest mean score was for serial number 4 which conveys that the faculty are highly satisfied with the college atmosphere. The minimum score is 3.71 for prescribed books in the library. Constant efforts in this direction can improve the score. The report has been transferred to the IQAC for further discussions and deliberations.

Action Taken Report on Teachers' Feedback

(2021-22)

- Feedback related to the various aspects of the institution was collected from the teachers in both the modes --- online & offline.
- Google Forms were sent to the teachers through Whatsapp groups.
- Some of the teachers collected feedback forms from the administrative block.
- 89 teachers recorded feedback this year.
- Google Forms were filled in by 50 teachers.
- 39 teachers furnished feedback offline.
- The collected feedback was put before the IQAC of the college for further analysis and discussion and finally the feedback report was recommended by the IQAC to be uploaded on the website of the college.
- Head of each department will be requested to give list of books to further enrich the library.
- To organize more sports activities, a ground will be provided.
- Besides ground for outdoor games, space as well as material for indoor games like chess, carom board etc. will be arranged.
- More activities will be planned for better results and holistic development.
- Separate gymnasiums for both boys and girls will be set up.



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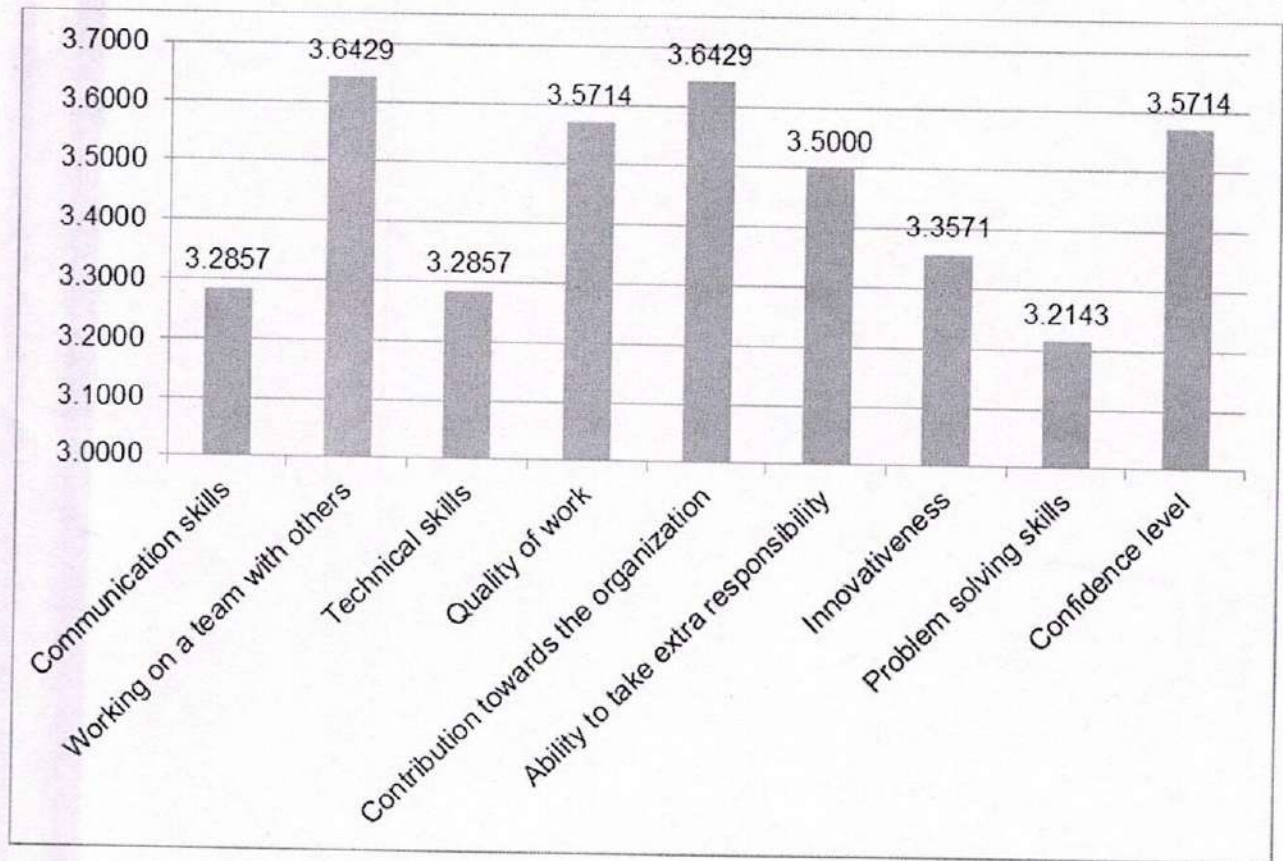
