

- The Abstracts/Research Papers should be typed in MS Word, 12 font size, Times New Roman and 1.5 line spacing.
- The Abstract should be limited upto 200 words only and the full length paper should be of 1500-2000 words.
- Plagiarism must not exceed the limit as permitted by the UGC.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to accept or reject the final paper at their discretion.
- Kindly send your Abstracts on or before 10th December, 2023 and Full Papers on or before 15th December, 2023.
- Send the full length paper on the conference E-mail Id
- The Organizing Committee may not accept the abstracts/papers submitted after the last date.
