

Sanction of the Governor of Haryana is pleased to allow Teacher Fellowship to Sh. Vikram Kumar, Asstt. Prof. in Chemistry, I.B. Post Graduate College, Panipat to complete Ph.D. under FIP scheme during the 12th Plan period from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra for two years or upto the period for which the salary of the substitute is reimbursed by University Grants Commission, which is earlier, on the following terms and conditions:-

1. Sh. Vikram Kumar, Lecturer in Chemistry will be entitled to receive full pay and allowances during the period of fellowship.
2. His entire period of fellowship will be treated as duty period for all intents and purpose.
3. If he requires to undertake any journey regarding her fellowship course, he will not be entitled to any TA/DA, conveyance and he will have to bear the cost of such travel/stay etc. from his own resources.
4. Sh. Vikram Kumar, Lecturer in Chemistry will neither be entitled to any additional remuneration nor any out of turn promotion on account of the qualifications acquired through this fellowship award.
5. During the fellowship period of Sh. Vikram Kumar, Lecturer in Chemistry, the expenditure on account of appointment of his substitute will be borne by UGC.
6. He will have to execute a bond to serve in his parent institution viz. I.B. Post Graduate College, Panipat for a period of 5 years at least, after the completion of his fellowship course as the terms of Finance Department letter No. 8709-3 FR-1/2494/22599 dated 22.10.1964 and No. 9723-3 FR-1/265/22599 dated 4.12.1965.
7. He will not be entitled to any special pay during the period of fellowship.
8. He will abide by all other terms and conditions that may be imposed later on by the Haryana Govt.
9. During the fellowship period of Sh. Vikram Kumar, Lecturer in Chemistry, a substitute will be appointed by the management of I.B. Post Graduate College, Panipat by making an agreement on contract basis as per guidelines issued by the Chief Secretary, Haryana.

Sub: - Award of Teacher fellowship to Sh. Vikram Kumar, Assistant professor Department of Chemistry, of I.B. College, Panipat, District Panipat, Haryana for completing Ph.D from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra in two years under FIP Scheme during 12th Plan period-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the letter No. CG-V/16/8790 dated 08.03.2016 received from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on the above subject and to convey the approval of the U.G.C. for award of Teacher Fellowship to Sh. Vikram Kumar, Assistant professor, Department of Chemistry of your College for completing Ph.D from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra under Faculty Improvement Programme for the period of two years from the date of his joining as teacher fellow.

The guidelines for the scheme for 12th Plan (Available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in) including the following Terms and conditions, are to be followed strictly.

1. The teacher will continue to receive full salary from the parent College during the period of teacher fellowship.
2. A teacher fellow will be eligible for reimbursement of actual contingency expenditure subject to a maximum of Rs.15, 000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) per year. The accounts for contingency grant and audited Utilization Certificate may be submitted to UGC.
3. Grants towards Contingency for the Teacher Fellowship for the first year will be paid to the research Centre/place of research of the Teacher Fellow on receipt of the Joining Report duly signed by Registrar/Principal/Research Guide of the University/College. The 2nd year's Contingency grant will be paid on receipt of Utilization Certificate for the 1st installment of grant duly signed by the Registrar/Principal/Research Guide of the University/College and item-wise statement of expenditure for the 2nd year.
4. The salary of the substitute teacher, appointed by the College in place of a teacher selected for award of Teacher Fellowship, will be paid by the UGC. The College will make a fresh appointment of a substitute teacher in accordance with the prescribed procedure of UGC, in the minimum pay scale prescribed for an Assistant Professor (with no increments). If the substitute teacher is appointed on a pay scale higher than the minimum pay scale of an Assistant Professor, the grant towards the salary of the substitute teacher will be restricted by the UGC to the minimum scale and the balance

amount will be met by the respective College or by the respective State Government. If the post vacated by the Teacher fellow is filled by transfer or deputation, such a substitute's salary will not be reimbursed. The substitute teacher must be appointed on a full time basis.


In case it is not possible to appoint a Substitute Teacher at the initial stage, or, if the appointment of a Substitute Teacher is delayed, then lectures may be arranged on the basis of honorarium of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) per lecture, subject to a maximum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) per month. Approval of affiliating University / State Government will not be necessary. However, all efforts should be made for the early appointment of a Substitute Teacher.

The Commission will not pay the salary of the substitute teacher if appointed on a part time basis, unless there are substantial reasons for same. The substitute teacher will not be entitled to yearly increments. The substitute teacher would also be entitled for salary for the extended period of the Teacher Fellow.

5. Grant towards salary of the substitute teacher (If appointed) will be paid to the College where the Teacher Fellow was working (parent institution) immediately before joining Teacher Fellowship on receipt of the month-wise details salary statement.
6. The supervisor/guide of the Teacher Fellow must give a 'progress report' after half the period of fellowship is over. In case of a negative report given by the Supervisor/Guide, the fellowship to the Teacher Fellow may be withdrawn by the UGC.
7. If a Teacher Fellow fails to complete his/her Ph.D./M.Phil Programme and leaves it midway, he/she has to refund the entire amount paid to him/her by the UGC during his/her Teacher Fellowship (Contingency grant + salary paid to the substitute teacher during the tenure of fellowship).

The College is requested to make appointment of substitute teacher immediately so that the related courses can run regularly.



4. **Government- Aided Colleges**

State Level Science Exhibition will be organized at Govt. College, Sector-1, Panchkula and Rs. 5.00 Lac is granted to Govt. College, Rohtak for organizing State Level Science Exhibition.

The above said amount sanctioned for each college shall be spent on activities like expenditure on projects/Models, refreshments for the participants, transportation costs of the participants for inter District and State Level Science Exhibition participation and other event related expenses like stationery, hospitality etc.

5. This amount i.e. Rs. 11.40 Lac related to Govt. aided Colleges will be drawn by Registrar Education office of Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula from the Haryana Treasury, Panchkula in lump sum and the payment will be sent to the Head of the institutions concerned as detailed in the scheme by Bank Transfer/RTGs. The amount will be utilized as per the directions of Director Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula. The Head of Institution will maintain accounts in this regard.
6. The expenditure shall be incurred in following phases **100% in a year.**

7. Date by which the entire expenditure shall be completed by **31.03.2022.**
8. Date by which the accounts should be rendered/compliance information given to the headquarter **31.03.2022.**
9. **Procedure to be followed:** This amount i.e. Rs. 11.40 Lac related to Govt. Aided Colleges will be drawn by Registrar Education office of Director Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula from the Haryana Treasury, Panchkula in lump sum and the payment will be sent to the Head of the institutions concerned as detailed in the scheme by Bank Transfer/RTGs. The amount will be utilized as per the directions of Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula. The Head of Institution will maintain accounts in this regard.

Guidelines for Science Exhibition for the session 2021-22

- i. For the year 2021-22, the students should be guided to prepare working models of utility based on the theme COVID-19 and IOT.
 - ii. IOT- the Internet of Things- this describes the network of physical objects “ Things” that are embedded with sensors, soft ware and other technology for the purpose of connecting and exchanging data with other devices and systems over the Internet} have been fixed for making working models of utility for the year 2021-22.
 - iii. The activities involving innovating ideas for preparations of working models such as role of sensors and other IT applications for detecting foul smells in public toilets, maintaining optimum greenery in the gardens and general cleanliness etc and Working models for dispensing of sanitizer in public places and other COVID related working models of utility should be encouraged.
 - iv. Principal of Govt. Colleges (concerned) will follow the SOP and guidelines strictly as per instructions issued by Central Govt. and State Govt. regarding COVID-19, during Science Exhibition.
 - v. Science Exhibition will be conducted only in Govt. Colleges of the State.
 - vi. Science Exhibition could be organized in offline/online mode.
10. The officer is responsible for implementing the scheme and the DDO shall strictly follow the guidelines given below:-

Subject-wise themes for the Science Exhibition 2021-22 are as under:

Subject	Themes
Physics	Basic principles of Physics; And Applied Electronics; Projects shall be related to sub themes of Applied Electronics, Mechanics, Heat, Optics, Wave Motion, Rocket Technology, Remote Sensing, and innovative projects related to Science and technology.
Chemistry	Applied Chemistry Projects shall be related to sub themes like Industrial Chemistry; Pharmaceuticals; Polymers; Adulterations Non-Technology; Chemistry in Milk products;
Botany	Applied Botany Projects shall be related to sub themes like utility of Plant Sciences in understanding Mankind, Role of Microbes; Genetic Engineering; Biogeochemical cycles; Physiology of Plants; Tissue culture; Transgenic Plants;
Zoology	Applied Zoology Projects shall be related to sub themes like Pathology; Economic Zoology; Physiology; Gene Cloning; Genetic Engineering; Integrated Pest Management; Aqua Culture;

Psychology	Role of Psychology –health and life Style Mental Health and Community; Stress – Thrill or Threat; Stress – Unmasking the Hidden Killer. Health promoting Life styles; Developmental Psychopathologic: Psychology and Social Issues;
Geography	Bio-diversity & Ecosystems; Physical landscapes; Desertification, Afforestation, Reforestation; Remote Sensing.
Computer Science	Animation To show/create real world application by virtual means through animation with the concepts of Artificial Intelligence being embedded where possible.

11. Mode of Implementation:

This event shall be organized at 2 levels –

1. Inter District Level Science Exhibition
2. State Level Science Exhibition

Inter District Level Science Exhibition:

Students of various classes in each college shall be given 3-4 projects in each subject mentioned above; to make working models. The best amongst these models will be taken to Inter-District Science Exhibition for display.

Each college shall get at least 4 models prepared on each sub-topic in each subject and select only one to be taken to Inter-College at the District Level Science Exhibition.

There are 269 colleges (97 Non Govt. aided Colleges and 172 Govt. Colleges) in the State, imparting Higher Education. Eleven Groups have been made so as each group has 15-20 colleges under its umbrella and the host Colleges is selected on the basis that colleges have all the facilities required for organizing the event.

At the Inter-college level, one model in each subject shall be recommended by a panel of judges.

For participation at each level, 1 prize shall be awarded if the number of participation is less than 3 exhibits. Similarly 2 prizes for participation level of 4-7 exhibits and 3 Prizes for participation of more than 7 exhibits in each subject.

The State Level Science Exhibition function will be organized at Govt. College, Rohtak and Rs. 5.00 Lac is granted to Govt. College, Rohtak for organizing State Level Science Exhibition. The recommended items from Inter-district Science Exhibition shall be displayed. This fund shall be spent on activities like stay of participants, Refreshment and food for the participants and event related expenses including prize money, honorarium of judges, stationery and hospitality etc.



It is mandatory for each college to participate in the above said events. Serious note will be taken against absentees.

The utilization Certificate must sent to this office.

12. Utilization of the sanctioned budget at the headquarter level shall be monitored by Joint Director NPE.
